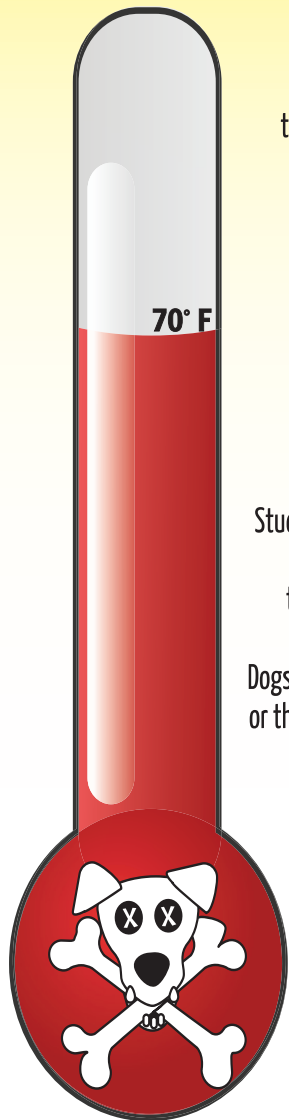


DOGS DIE IN HOT CARS

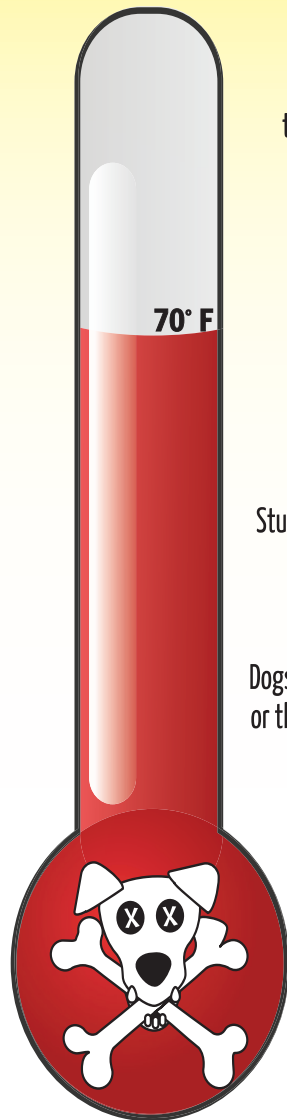

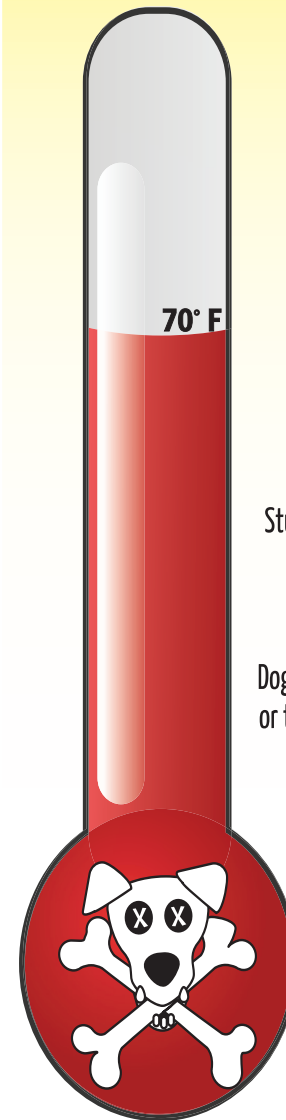
